The text to be printed must be presented before the expiration date of **June 1st, 2010**.

The text must be sent within this period by Email to ulderico.mazzi@unipd.it in both **.pdf** and **.doc** extensions. Communication of the good quality of the manuscript will be send soon to the sender.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MANUSCRIPT PREPARATION

The manuscripts will be collected in the volume of “*Technetium, and other radiometals in Chemistry and Medicine*” and reproduced directly from the original paper copy by photographic process with 20% reduction, so no subsequent alterations are allowed.

To ensure an efficient publication of your manuscript, please read carefully the following instructions and follow them strictly.

1. The full paper must not exceed 14 printed pages for Reviews and Plenary Lectures, 6 printed pages for Oral Presentations and 4 printed pages for Posters.
2. Each page (including title, authors, affiliations and references) must fit in an area of **160 mm** (width) and **240 mm** (depth).
All text should be in **Times New Roman, 12-point** font (except for title, affiliations, references and captions, see below), **14-point exact** line space (except for affiliations, see below).
3. *Title, authors and affiliation:*
 - a) The title must be centred and typed on the first page in bold-face block capitals, 14-point font.
 - b) After two full line space the author(s) name(s) must be centred and typed in upper and lower case, the initials preceding the surname, 12-point font.
Superscript numbers may be added to names to denote affiliations (see below).
 - c) After two full line space the author(s) affiliation(s) should be centred and typed in upper and lower case, 10-point font, with 12-point exact line space.
Different affiliations can be denoted by the use of superscript numbers. If so, each author’s name should bear a superscript number denoting the correct affiliation. Full address and postal code should be given.
 - d) After three 14-point exact line space the article should begin.

5. *Sections of the text*
Except for Plenary Lectures, text must be divided into: **Keywords, Abstract, Introduction, Experimental, Result and Discussion, Conclusion, Acknowledgments** (if desired), **References**. If desired, Experimental and Result and Discussion can be divided in sub-sections. In Plenary Lectures, Experimental and Result and Discussion can be substituted by other sections decided by the author.
Sections headings should be typed on the left-hand margin of the page, in bold-face block capitals. Sub-sections headings should be typed on the left-hand margin of the page, in upper and lower case, preferably in italic.
Do not leave any space below headings and sub-headings. One full line space should be left between the text of one section and the heading of the following one.
Each paragraph must have a 1 cm first line indentation.
6. *Keywords*
The contributors must present not more than 5 keywords at the beginning of their paper. Keywords should be typed on the same line of the heading, in upper and lower case.
7. *Abstract*
The body of the manuscript should be preceded by an abstract (not more than ten lines) which should be a synopsis of the entire article.
8. *References*
References to published literature should be quoted in the text by the appropriate reference number, in square parentheses.
The reference section should be placed at the end of the manuscript. References must be arranged as:

9. *Equations*
Equations may be added to the text, centred, with a full line space above and below. They should be numbered consecutively (on the right-hand margin of the page, in parentheses) using Arabic numerals where they are referred to in the text.
10. *Illustrations*
Illustrations and drawings must be pasted within the text. Each figure must be numbered consecutively and captioned, with a single line space between the figure and the caption. Caption text size should be in italic 11-point font.
Leave a single line space above the figure and below the caption.
Please remember that **figures size will be reduced** along with the rest of the layout sheet. Illustrations must be sharp, clear and in black and white colour.

Coloured pages are very expensive. **The authors should use only grey-tone, black and white figures.** In case they cannot avoid the use of coloured images, they will have to pay the cost of the printing, in agreement with the publisher's informations.

11. *Tables*

Results should be tabulated wherever possible. Table should also be placed where it is more appropriate in the text. Tables should be numbered consecutively and captioned on the top, with a single line space between the caption and the table. Caption text should be in italic 11-point font.

Leave a single line space above the caption and below the table.

All table columns should have an explanatory heading. Table should not repeat data already presented elsewhere in the paper, e.g. in a line diagram. Data should not be duplicated in figures and text.

12. Formulae should be numbered consecutively, using Arabic numerals where they are referred to in the text.
13. Nomenclature, abbreviations and symbols shall follow the latest rules of the International Union of Pure and Applied Chemistry (IUPAC). In IUPAC nomenclature, isotopic substitution is indicated by a suffix consisting of (1) any necessary locant numeral or numerals; (2) the atomic symbol with the mass number as a superscript to the left of the symbol, (3) a subscript (other than unity) indicating the number of such atoms. Trivial names should be avoided unless the compound is to be mentioned often in the text, in which case a systematic name should be given the first time the trivial name is used.

(WGY-COSTXXX). ¹ Affiliation 1, full address and postal code (two 14-point exact full line space after the authors section, centred in Times New Roman 10-point font, upper and lower case, with 12-point exact line space)

² Affiliation 2, full address and postal code

KEYWORDS: not more than 5 keywords (three 14-point exact full line space after the affiliations section, centred in Times New Roman 12-point font, upper and lower case, with 14-point exact line space).

ABSTRACT (one 14-point exact full line space after the previous section)

Abstract text (not more than ten lines, Times New Roman 12-point font, with 14-point exact line space, 1 cm first line indentation).

INTRODUCTION (one 14-point exact full line space after the previous section)

Introduction text (Times New Roman 12-point font, with 14-point exact line space, 1 cm first line indentation). References to publications should be numbered consecutively in square parentheses (i.e. [1]).

EXPERIMENTAL (one 14-point exact full line space after the previous section)

Experimental text (Times New Roman 12-point font, with 14-point exact line space, 1 cm first line indentation).

Sub-section (one 14-point exact full line space after the previous section)

Sub-section text (Times New Roman 12-point font, with 14-point exact line space, 1 cm first line indentation).

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION (one 14-point exact full line space after the previous section)

Results and Discussion text (Times New Roman 12-point font, with 14-point exact line space, 1 cm first line indentation). Black and white colour illustrations should be pasted within the text, captioned below, numbered consecutively, with one 14-point exact full line space above the illustration and one below the caption.

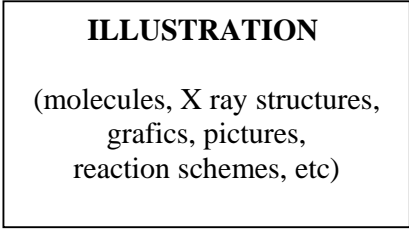


Fig. 1: caption (italic Times New Roman 11-point font, 14-point exact line space). Leave one full line after the caption.
